



- Curb ramps requested by citizens






- City's recent ADA curb ramp inventory
  - 2017-2018: Surveyed and collected curb ramp data
  - Approximately 12,000 intersections and 29,700 curb ramp locations (existing and missing ramps)

**Missing Ramp** 






 A schedule and plan for making all the City's curb ramps ADA-compliant

  - **Priority 1 (P1)** City Government Offices and Facilities
  - Priority 2 (P2) Transportation Corridors
  - Priority 3 (P3) Hospitals, Medical Facilities, Assisted
     Living Facilities, and Other Similar Facilities
  - Priority 4 (P4) Places of Public Accommodation Such as
     Commercial and Business Zones
  - Priority 5 (P5) Facilities Containing Employers
  - **Priority 6 (P6)** Residential
