12.16.1 Communications-Public Safety Radio Dispatchers Training Pay.

Public Safety Communication Specialists or Public Safety Radio
Dispatchers shall be eligible for additional pay equal to
approximately seven and one-half percent (7.5%) five percent (5%)
of the employee's current rate of pay for each hour the employee is
assigned and is actually engaged in one-on-one training of a
Dispatcher trainee.
