

another **2.5** became homeless


For every **1** household housed, another **1.7** became homeless

What is Safe Parking generally?

- Safe place to park off-street on a temporary basis
- Managed by a social service provider
- Can be for individuals and/or families
- Secure with access to health, social services & hygiene







Safe Parking Model

The Goals of the RV Safe Parking Program include:

- Assisting RV residents in obtaining needed social and/or employment services to support their transition to permanent housing
- Reducing/eliminating RV residencyrelated impacts on neighborhoods and businesses
- Eliminating RV residency-related environmental and public health impacts



BUILDING GREAT PLACES

Onsite Services & model:

- Security
- Restrooms
- Waste Management
- Grey Water Disposal
- Onsite Operator 24/7
- Good Neighbor Policy
- Quiet Hours (10 pm 7:00 am)
- Site Control: Referral Only

RV Safe Parking at Berryessa

Minimum Site Criteria:

- Minimum of 125 standard vehicle size parking spaces
- Inspected for Fire Code compliance, including enough space to allow proper spacing between vehicles and entry and exit point;
- Paved parking lot with fencing for secured access control;
- Established lighting at the site and power sources;
- Access to a sewer line and water hook-ups.
- Ability to use 24/7
- Spacing for onsite trash, portable restrooms/hand washing stations, shower truck, staff office
