### **BACKGROUND**

With their approval of the Mayor's March Budget Message for Fiscal Year 2023-2024, the City Council directed the Administration to provide a cost estimate for vacant building blight enforcement.

## **ANALYSIS**

The proactive and reactive response, monitoring, and enforcement of Vacant Building and Storefronts code compliance is funded in the General Fund. When such properties fail to respond to initial corrective action, by directive of existing code, they can then be placed into a fee-based monitoring program. This scope would provide additional staffing to increase the proactive and reactive response and meet requirements once placed in the monitoring program to reduce blight and improve safety and maintenance of vacant buildings and storefronts, as well as enhance the overall Vacant Building and Storefront Enforcement program.

The estimated costs and related position needs are detailed below.
