The Roundtable neighborhood in District 2 is currently served by Project Hope and is an opportunity zone for community improvements and investments that will deter crime, improve the quality of life and create pride in the area. Roundtable Dr is a densely populated street that backs a shopping center that has been a source of loitering and illegal dumping. Roundtable Dr. from Roeder Rd to Bendorf Dr. is poorly maintained. We suggest investing of the beautification of the area directly behind the Edenvale Shopping Center. Beautification efforts should include removal of 3-4 large unmaintained trees that in are in poor health, replacing the area with new trees, purchasing ground cover and other landscaping measures to clean and beautify the area. District 2 has already secured support from Our City Forest for the planting of new trees and the Roundtable Neighborhood Association has committed to the proper care and maintenance of the new trees and area.

Roundtable Dr., from Roeder Rd. to Driveway is the project area identified by Council District 2 staff. DOT has informed the Council District 2 staff that this area is private property, based on CSJ development maps and additional research performed by DOT including original and updated parcel maps. District 2 staff requested that DOT submit a cost estimate so that they may work with the adjacent property owner(s) to implement this project. The property owner would fund and complete the landscape improvements to their property.

The cost estimate is provided below to inform investment necessary to beautify the area of interest funded by the property owner. Ongoing maintenance cost is not included in the analysis below.

- Clean up/site preparation (48 hrs) = \$3,000
- Plant material costs: 250 misc. 5 gallon plants = \$7,500
- 75 cubic yards of brown Pro Chip mulch = \$12,000

- Labor plant installation (64 hrs) and mulch installation (36 hrs) = \$7,000
- Fertilizer = \$300

Subtotal = \$30,000

Tree removal cost estimate

Based on DOT's inspection of the referenced trees, only one tree should be removed. This cost estimate for its removal is below.

- 1 tree removal = \$4,200
- 1 stump grind = \$550

Subtotal = \$4,750

25% contingency = \$8,688

TOTAL = \$43,438, inclusive of a 25% contingency.

Tree planting cost estimate – For reference

The cost estimate request indicates that OCF will be planting the trees. For reference, unit cost for planting one 15 -gallon tree with three years establishment is \$1,000. DOT identified sufficient planting space for 8 trees for a total estimated cost of \$8,000.
