Proposal Description, including anticipated outcomes (describe how change would affect services for San Jose residents, businesses, community groups, etc.):

When there is an emergency in the City our Firefighters go out to respond promptly to the emergency. Unfortunately, cars do not move to the side to let our Firefighters pass, which has led to a decrease in our Fire Department reaching its target response of 8 minutes for Priority 1 calls. The City has a target goal of responding within 8 minutes of Priority 1 service calls 80% of the time. For this fiscal year '22-'23 it is estimated that our Fire Unit will reach its target goal of response, only 67% of the time.

Having cameras on firetrucks will allow us to deter community members from not yielding. As well as giving drivers a reminder that it is the law to move to the side when there is Firetruck with their emergency lights and sound on. During the Public Safety, Finance, and Strategic Support Committee, we saw the heat map with areas with Late Response Times. The cameras should be a pilot program for the top 5 fire stations with the latest response times to see if the cameras have any effect on response times.
