To help boost the quality of East San José commercial corridors, twice a year, these corridors should be power washed to beautify the area. Please consider the following BD to pay to power wash commercial corridors in East San José, including the stretches of:

- 1. Alum Rock Avenue 680 to Millar Avenue,
- 2. King Road Alum Rock Ave to Story Road,
- 3. Story Road King Road to Clayton Road.
