Our public libraries play an important role in providing resources, access to information, and educational opportunities to people of all ages. They can also serve as a social hub, where community events occur. However, late fees for overdue materials are a major barrier to library use, especially for our senior community.

While the emergency declaration has ended, COVID-19 continues to be a risk for seniors, who also may suffer from mobility issues and other health conditions which could impact their ability to return library materials on time.

There are financial considerations as well that make this a worthwhile investment. Seniors are often on fixed incomes and could be struggling to make ends meet in our increasingly unaffordable region. By

waiving these fees, seniors can take advantage of all that our libraries have to offer without having to fear the repercussions that accompany late fees.

In the digital age, seniors also may need additional support and guidance in using online resources and devices. By waiving late fees, libraries can provide more time and assistance to seniors who may need extra support in utilizing the library's digital resources and platforms.

This grant will be a valuable investment for our seniors, giving them the support they need to maintain good emotional and cognitive health, connect with their fellow community members, and continue to live with dignity.
