LBFSV's small business services are multilingual and focus on women, as they represent over 80% of those we support. The small business services most accessed by entrepreneurs include our Business Academy, Single Mother Business Owner and Mujeres Imparables programs. Mujeres Imparables provides support to survivors of domestic violence that seek to start a new business to support their financial independence. Through shared conversations and learnings, this peer-support program was piloted in 2022 to support the most vulnerable throughout San Jose. Many in our community expressed interest in becoming entrepreneurs as a way to support their journeys of financial independence and empowerment.
